I have worked as an architect in Paris for about 15 years, including renovation of the Grand Palais and Musée des Invalides, and various contemporary buildings
From 1998 to 2002 I worked in New-York city, doing stage architecture, including the Tigers stadium in Detroit. My personal interests in science led me to be a designer of exhibitions for the American Museum of Natural History for 2years.
